- Nominee must be a person of such integrity, stature and demonstrated ability that the faculty, staff, students and alumni will take pride in and be inspired by the recognition of this person (statement of support and/or examples).
- Nominee must be an individual who, in deeds and action, reflects and recognizes the importance of education received at UTMB, and who demonstrates pride in the alma mater and whose interest and loyalty are evident (statement of support and/or examples).
- Nominee has made contributions to medical/healthcare education through teaching (including workshops/presentations), research, preceptorships, and/or publications (statement of support and/or examples listed).
- Nominee must be a graduate of UTMB at Galveston **for at least 10 years** from the Physician Assistant Studies Program.

the PAS Alumni Association Board of Directors Awards Committee.**
